Please note:

Players who played in an older age group in 2022 should assume they will be playing in their correct age group in 2023 and must attend the appropriate session.

The Grading Committee who will be watching the players and assigning positions are all highly experienced netball players and coaches, being involved at representative, state and national levels. Their independent opinion is highly regarded by the club, and we follow their recommendations when forming teams for the season. Committee members are not involved with the formation of teams in which they have children or family members playing.

Parents are welcome to stay during Grading, following are the instructions for entry to PLC:

- Entry to the car park is via Gate 3 on Avon Road.
- After you have parked your car walk upstairs and continue to the right, passing the Aquatic Centre up to the entrance to the Indoor Courts.
- Netball uniforms do not need to be worn at these sessions.

Preparation for your session:

- Please arrive 15 minutes before your grading time to sign in and start warming up. The session will start on time and we need all players at the court ready to go – late arrivals may miss their game(s).
- Bring a full labelled water bottle, no snacks inside the gym please.
- Please have any medications (eg asthma puffer, EPI pen) with you on the day, and alert a committee member if you require assistance.
- All players will have a number written on their arm and leg in sharpie, so please wear shorts and short sleeves.

During the grading session:

- Please listen carefully to all instructions, especially when positions are being assigned.
- Players will take the court at least twice during the trial and may be asked to play in any position required by the graders on the day.
- Positions have been set by the grading committee and ALL players will play in their assigned position, please do not request alternate positions for your child.
- If parents have questions, please ask a LNC Committee Member or the Registration desk.
- We will be using both courts during all Grading Sessions on 19 February. Spectators will need to remain in the designated area near the entrance, and age groups will be required to stay at their court to facilitate quick change-overs.
