KNA 2025 - Winter Comp Borrowing Guidelines



All enquiries are to be directed to the Grading Committee

Guidelines are found on the KNA website and attached to the scoreboard each week.

PENALTIES will apply from WEEK 1

Guidelines Applying to ALL Players and Competitions

- o A registered player of a team can NOT be displaced by a borrowed player
- A player may be borrowed any number of times throughout the season.
- All borrowed players must sign the score sheet, noting their registered team, prior to taking the court
- o A **NON-Registered** player must not take the court, penalties will apply.
- A maximum of 2 (two) Representative players from within your own club can be borrowed per game during the regular season and only 1 (one) for the final's series
- The borrowed player MUST play in the borrowing team's bib.
- o Borrowed players can wear their own uniform.

BORROWING Guidelines for each DIVISION

- The **TOP Grade** in each division is **NOT PERMITTED** to borrow across the grade or from other clubs. That is **A1, CADET 1, INTERMEDIATE 1, 12A, 11A and 10A.**
- **ALL OTHER Grades** Borrowing **IS PERMITTED**, across the grade and from other clubs provided it falls within the Borrowing Guidelines.

SENIOR GRADES - may borrow from any grade lower in this order

A1; A2; Cadet 1; A3; Cadet 2; A4; B1; B2; Cadet 3; B3; Cadet 4; Cadet 5

Players aged **14 years** as of 31st December 2025, are **NOT** permitted to play in any Senior teams. Players aged **15 years** as of 31st December 2025, **CAN** be borrowed into Senior teams with approval from the borrowed player's club.

For players **registered in both CADETS and SENIORS** - approval for their borrowing will be based on the higher registered grade on the Senior Grades Order of Borrowing

CADET GRADES

Players aged 12 years are NOT permitted to play in any Cadet teams.

Players aged **13 years** as of 31st December 2025, **CAN** be borrowed into Cadet teams with approval from the borrowed player's club and player's parent.

Players **registered in both CADETS and SENIORS** - approval for their borrowing will be based on the higher registered grade on the Senior Grades Order of Borrowing

Players aged **11 years** or under as of 31st December 2025, are **NOT** permitted to play in Intermediate teams Players aged **12 years** as of 31st December 2025, **CAN** be borrowed into Intermediate teams

NSG LOFBERG Grades

Only players registered in a NSG team playing at Lofberg are eligible for borrowing into NSG teams

	Players aged 5 and 6 as of 31st December 2025, are NOT to be borrowed into 7/8 years or 8-year grades under any circumstances
NSG 7/8 teams	Across grade; players 7 and 8 year olds as of 31st December 2025
	Players aged 5 and 6 as of 31st December 2025, are NOT to be borrowed into 7/8 years or 8-year grades under any circumstances
NSG 6/7 teams	Across grade; players 5, 6 and 7 year olds as of 31st December 2025
	Players aged 8 as of 31st Dec 2025, are <u>NOT</u> to be borrowed into 6/7year grades <u>under any circumstances</u>

Requests to Borrow Outside the Guidelines

- A player requesting a borrowing exemption may NOT take the court prior to approval being granted from KNA Grading Convenor / Committee or a KNA Executive member
- Any requests for exemption to borrow outside the Borrowing Guidelines, need to be submitted via email to the KNA Grading Convenor at knagrad@kna.com.au the day prior to play
- Approval to borrow on the day of play must be done via email to the KNA Grading Convenor or a KNA
 Executive member who will liaise with the Grading Committee. Approval must be recorded on the score sheet
- Penalties WILL apply if borrowing outside of these guidelines. Refer Bylaws 21(a)

Borrowing for the Finals Series

Players may only **represent ONE team on Grand Final Day**, with the exception of a player who is registered in both a Cadet & Opens team.

For the finals series, provided a player is borrowed within the KNA Borrowing Guidelines

- Players do NOT need to play in a team to qualify
- Players do NOT need to be transferred into a team to play

Representative Players:

- A maximum of 1 (one) **Representative players** can be borrowed for the final's series from your own club.
- During final series games a maximum of 1 (one)representative player may be borrowed (within the rep points policy)

Borrowing from another club:

- During the finals series all teams must have grading approval to borrow from another club
- The borrowing club must confirm players name, club and registered grade with the Grading Convenor and KNA Registrar in writing prior to play
- The borrowing club must provide details these on the score sheet

Forfeits

Under existing competition rules and Bylaws 21(a)-(f), penalties may apply following a team forfeit.

Late Registration of New Players

All late registrations (after 4th March 2025) must have KNA Grading Committee approval prior to their online registration. Online **club** registrations **MUST** be completed **48 hours** prior to playing.

The grading committee when assessing a player's late registration will take into consideration the following:

- a player wishing to register in a team 2 grades below their previous playing grade
- a player requesting to play in a team 2 years above their age as of 31st December
- a player wishing to register in a team where the late registration equates to 5 or more returning players from the previous season
- a player's representative history
